Business Service Centre

There is a Business Service Centre in the World Trade Centre (connected to the VCC and Pan Pacific Hotel) available on a fee-for-use basis. Within the Convention Centre or Pan Pacific, take the elevator to 'R' Level and turn right as you exit the elevator. 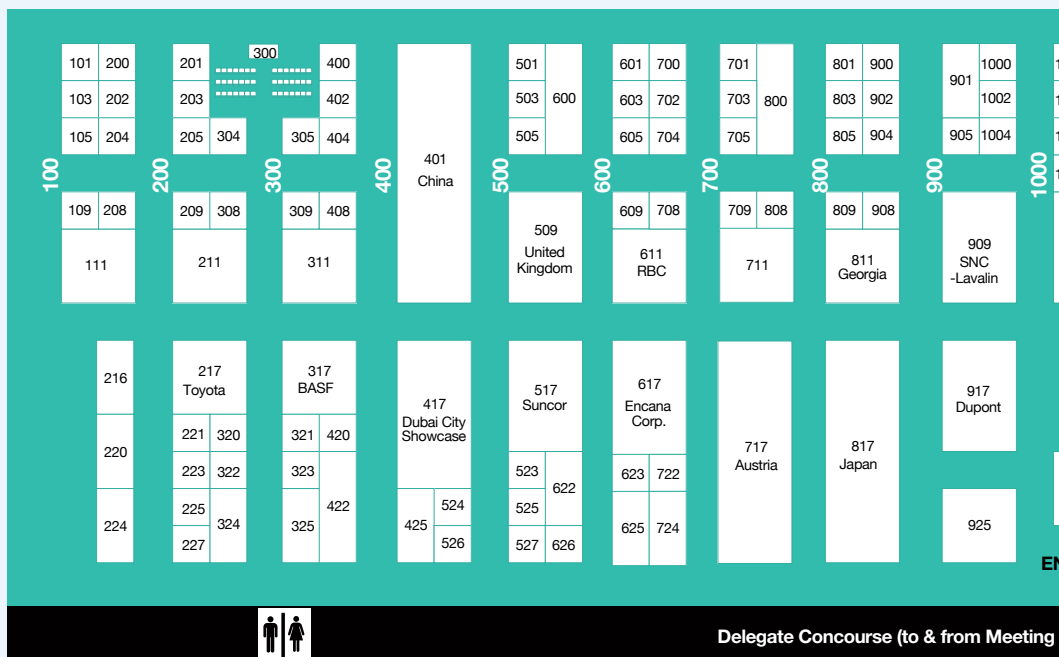

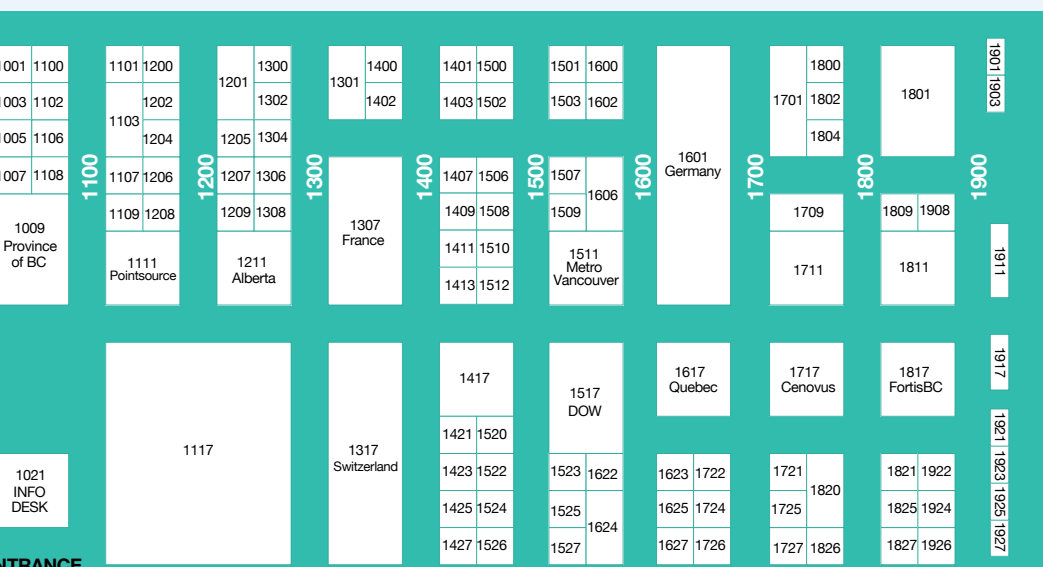
TRADE FAIR FLOORPLAN
