From 28 November to 9 December 2005, Montreal will host the Climate Change Conference. This is the eleventh session of the Conference of the Parties (COP11) and the first meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (MOP1).

More than 7,000 participants from the Conference's 189 Parties are expected to attend, including representatives from government and non-governmental organizations, intergovernmental organizations, the public sector and international media.

Among the events being organized to accompany the UN Climate Change Conference, the **Climate Change Solutions Showcase** will highlight Canadian expertise in dealing with the challenge of climate change. This will be a unique opportunity for Canadian organizations to profile their programs, solutions and proven technologies dedicated to the reduction of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. It will also recognize the positive and mutually supporting roles of the federal, provincial and municipal governments, NGOs, youth, and the public and private sectors in addressing this challenge.

The Showcase will be held December 6 - 9, 2005 at the Complexe Guy-Favreau, a dynamic thoroughfare used by thousands of Montrealers every day, as well as delegates attending the COP11 – MOP1 meetings. Both delegates and the general public are welcome to attend the Showcase.
